Purpose of Professional Guide

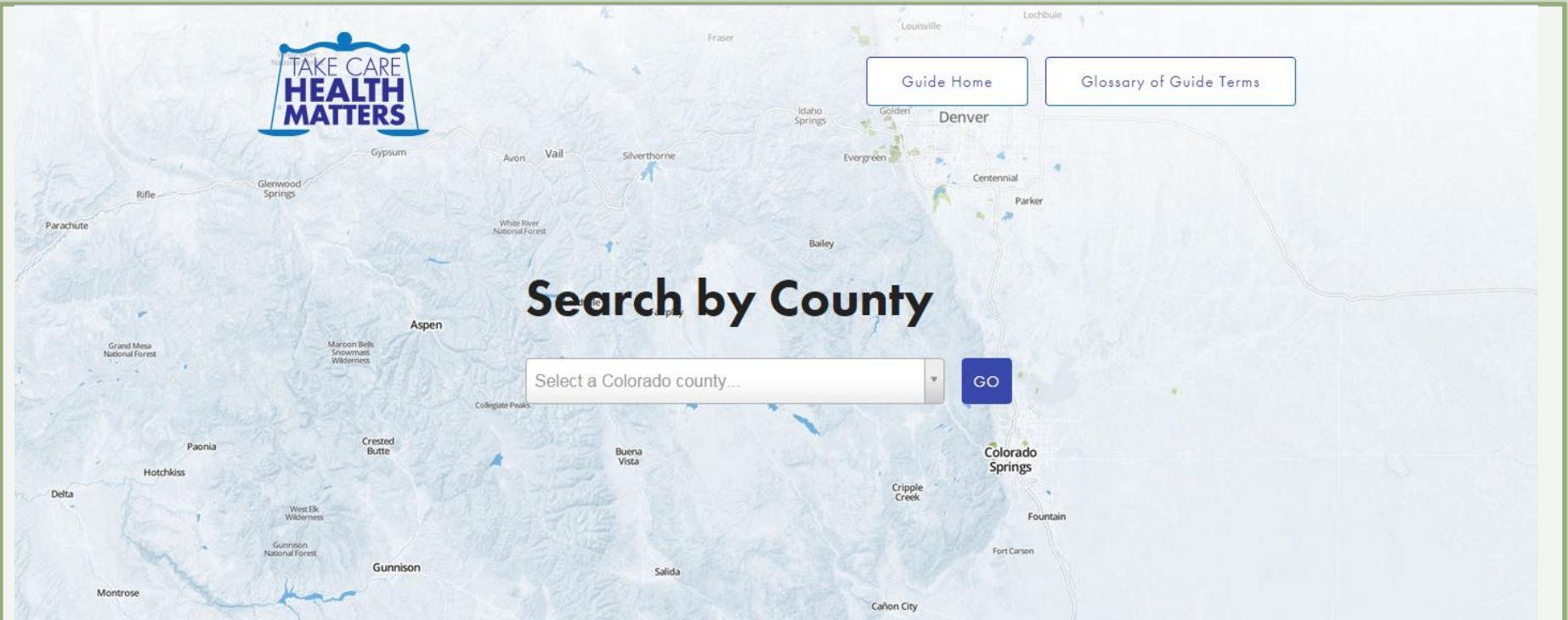


- Provide county level health and criminal justice-related information to professionals in these fields to help build relationships and improve access to health care services for justice involved individuals.

Callout 1: You can manually enter a client's address or click "Get my location" to access results based on your current location (i.e. your office).

Callout 2: Select various types of care such as behavioral/mental health, general health, oral/dental health and more.

Callout 3: To access providers who accept Medicaid, select "Medicaid/CHP + Accepted" under the Advanced Filters section.

Filters: Type of Care, Advanced Filters, Keyword Search, Safety-Net Type, Services Provided, Age Groups Served, Populations Served, Languages Spoken, Payment Assistance & Special Accommodations.
